## 1. General description

The 74LV7032A-Q100 is a quad 2-input OR function with Schmitt-trigger inputs, capable of transforming slowly changing input signals into sharply defined, jitter-free output signals.

Inputs are overvoltage tolerant. This feature allows the use of these devices as translators in mixed voltage environments.

This device is fully specified for partial power down applications using  $I_{OFF}$ . The  $I_{OFF}$  circuitry disables the output, preventing the potentially damaging backflow current through the device when it is powered down.

This product has been qualified to the Automotive Electronics Council (AEC) standard Q100 (Grade 1) and is suitable for use in automotive applications.












Fig. 6. Package outline SOT402-1 (TSSOP14)
