






Fig. 3. Per transistor: Transient thermal impedance from junction to ambient as a function of pulse duration; typical values



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



Fig. 5. Collector current as a function of collectoremitter voltage; typical values











Fig. 8. Off-state input voltage as a function of collector current; typical values

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
11.2 Resistor calculation

$$\frac{R2}{R1} = \frac{V(I14) - V(I13)}{R1 \cdot (I14 - I13)} - 1$$

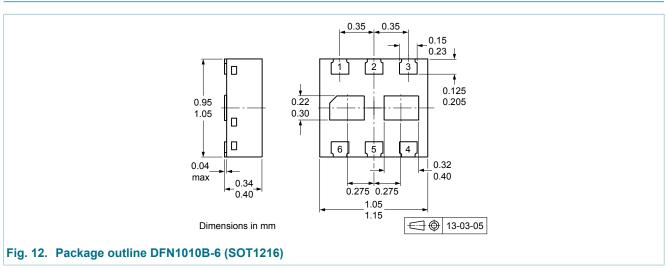


